STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES

In order to relieve, as much as possible, the distress resulting from present legal methods of dealing with intoxicating liquor, and as steps toward a final solution of the liquor problem, we strongly urge:

STATE

1. That our State Legislature deal with beer as legally intoxicating liquor and thus conform to the constitution of the state (Article VI. Section 46.) which forbids and penalizes "the consumption and the sale thereof for consumption in a saloon or other public place."

2. That an adequate and workable local option law which includes the sale of beer be enacted.
3. That the insertion in public school text-books of material concerning the effects of alcohol on the human body be a legal requirement.
4. That municipalities shall continue to be restrained by law from sharing in the revenue collected from the sales of intoxicating liquor.

F E D E R A L

5. That support be given to the Capper-Culkin and Capper-Johnson Bills which when enacted into law, will prohibit all forms of liquor advertising in dry states and liquor advertising by radio everywhere.
