



WEST VIRGINIA MINERS' HOSPITAL NO. 1
For Year Ending September 30, 1904.

WELCH, WEST VIRGINIA, OCTOBER 1, 1904.

HON. A. B. WHITE, *Governor of West Virginia, Charleston.*

SIR:—In compliance with the laws of the State of West Virginia, I beg to submit herewith report of the West Virginia Miners' Hospital No. 1, for the year ended September 30, 1904, to which is attached the Treasurer's balance sheet, detailed statement of patients treated during the year and statement of operating expenses for the same period.

At the annual meeting of the Board, held in July last, the officers who had served during the previous year were reelected, and Dr. Chas. F. Hicks was elected Superintendent to succeed Dr. S. S. Gale, resigned. Dr. H. L. Botsford was appointed House Surgeon. During the year there was an average of seventeen employes in the Hospital, the average pay roll amounting to \$600.00 per month. The average number of patients treated in the institution daily, not including the numerous dispensary cases disposed of during the year, was thirty-two. From the foregoing it will be noticed that there was an average of forty-nine persons (including employes) in the Hospital at all times. The maintenance appropriation for the past year allowed just forty-five cents per person per day for all expenses, which, as can be readily seen, is wholly inadequate to properly maintain the institution.

The Board earnestly recommends that the annual appropriation for maintenance be made \$18,000.00, instead of \$12,000.00, as at present.

In addition to the appropriation for maintenance requested above, the Board would respectfully ask for an appropriation of \$13,700.00, for the improvements and betterments enumerated below, each one of which is urgently needed to bring the service and usefulness of the institution to the degree of perfection which the present Board hopes to attain.

First:—\$1,000 for an increased water supply, including dam across the creek, tank, pump, pipe, etc.

Second:—\$1,000 for a laundry building. The laundry at present is done outside the Hospital at an average monthly cost of \$165.00. With a building of this nature and an increased water supply, as outlined above, this expense could be reduced to less than half of the present outlay.

Third:—\$800.00 for an ambulance and two horses. This is most urgently needed on account of the rough road and the distance from the railway station to the Hospital.

Fourth:—\$1,000 for X-Ray machine and numerous necessary surgical instruments.

Fifth:—\$1,000 for an hydraulic elevator for conveying patients to the operating room on the third floor.

Sixth:—\$500 to complete the operating room with tiling, making it aseptic.

Seventh:—\$1,200 for carpets, furniture and rugs for the stairs and halls, the floors of which are at present bare; for linen, bedding and mattresses, which have been in service since the Hospital was opened to the public.

Eighth:—\$1,200 for repairing and painting roof and exterior of the building and many necessary repairs to the interior.

Ninth:—\$2,000 for fuel and expense of running the lighting plant in connection with the Hospital.

Tenth:—\$4,000 for a home for the Superintendent and nurses. This would relieve the second floor of the Hospital building and render it available for the use of private patients. The number of private, or pay patients, which can now be accommodated is greatly below the demands made upon the Hospital for space for this class of patients, and a building as described above, would permit of the reception and care of a large number of desirable and profitable cases which cannot be entertained at present.

In conclusion, I take pleasure in advising that all the employes in the Hospital have been faithful and zealous in the performance of their respective duties.
