

Today we bid farewell to the old church. It was dedicated on Sunday, June 4th, 1854, by Bishop Scott and Dr. Adel Stevens, the historian of Methodism. For more than a half a century this has been a place of worship; as a property it has increased many times in value, which has been continued in the new enterprise to go on serving God and uplifting humanity. As we leave the old, and shall soon go into the new let us take a message from the poet, Oliver Wendell Holmes:

"Build thee more stately mansions, O my soul,
As the swift seasons roll.
Leave thy low-vaulted past;
Let each new temple, nobler than the last,
Shut thee from heaven with a dome more vast,
Till thou at length art free,
Leaving thine outgrown shell by life's unresting sea."
